Award 1 – QSPA Award for Leadership in the Profession

Award 2 – QSPA Lifetime Achievement Award

Significant contribution to Queensland state education and to the work of QSPA over an extended period of time

Award 3 – *QSPA Achievement Award*

Significant contribution to the work of QSPA in recent years

Award 4 – QSPA Life Membership

Is conferred following the retirement/resignation from the Department of Education to QSPA full members of good standing for long and committed service to QSPA.

Recognises members who through their long-standing membership of the Association have provided strong support to QSPA and fellow members.

- Recipients will be invited to attend the QSPA Conference for the relevant Award presentation.

- QSPA membership confirmed (past/current)
- Significant level of contribution to QSPA/state education
- Impact on profession, colleagues and/or leadership
- Achievement of outcomes
